



10 night "5 rivers" itinerary: Kwara, Lagoon, Lebala, Ntwala & Stanley's Maun to Livingstone

- Arrive into Maun and transferred by light aircraft bound for Kwara
- 2 nights Kwara
- Light aircraft transfer to Lagoon
- 2 nights Lagoon
- Game drive transfer to Lebala
- 2 night Lebala
- Light aircraft transfer to Kasane
- Road and boat transfer to Ntwala
- 2 nights Ntwala
- Boat and road transfer to Stanley's Safari Lodge in Livingstone
- 2 nights Stanley's Safari Lodge
- Transfer to Livingstone Airport – tour ends

On arrival at Maun Airport, you will be met by a Kwando/Moremi Air representative who will introduce you to your pilot and show you onto your light aircraft for a departure out of Maun.

Your first stop is **Kwara**, deep in the clear permanent waters of the Okavango Delta. Time at Kwara will reveal why the Delta, with all its remarkable plant, bird and animal life, is unique in the world.

Overnight 2 nights at Kwara

Kwara camp is situated on the edge of the permanent waters of the world renowned Okavango Delta in Botswana, and shares a common boundary with Moremi Game Reserve. Due to the specific location of the camp, Kwara is able to offer, power boating, mokoro (dug out canoe) trips, walks and game drives – all year round. Kwara also offers fishing for 10 months of the year, but due to Government regulations we are not permitted to fish during January or February as this is peak breeding season. In addition Kwara is in a large private concession enabling the game drives to operate both off road and at night.



The water experience, either fishing, on a mekoro or exploring the channels and rivers by boat, is spectacular. Kwara also offers game drives both off road and at night in our own private traverse area.

The exclusive traverse is a feature of the Kwando Safaris experience – while Kwara camp adjoins the Moremi Game Reserve you only have to share your game experience with other Kwara guests. The best all year round Delta experience.



After a morning activity and a leisurely breakfast on the day of departure from Kwara – you will board another light aircraft for your transfer to **Lagoon**.

Overnight **2 nights** in the intimate and tranquil atmosphere of **Lagoon**. Set on the banks of an oxbow of the Kwando River, Lagoon is remote and beautiful. For many months of the year you'll see elephant drinking from the water next to the camp and witness the huge herds of buffalo that keep close proximity to the Kwando River.



Wild dogs, lion, cheetah, leopard and hyena are all never far away from their food sources. Over the years, many of our guests have been fortunate enough to see some of the incredible interactions between predator and prey species. Sometimes, even predator against predator.

These are ancient struggles that very few people in the world are privileged to witness.



On the morning of departure from Lagoon as your early morning activity you will be transferred by road to **Lebala**.

Overnight Lebala for 2 nights





Lebala is hidden in the southern portion of the extensive Kwando wilderness of 232, 000 hectares and the word means wide open spaces, the area is a labyrinth of waterways, reed beds, islands and floodplains, bush, scrub and trees. Excellent general game abounds the broad plains creating spectacular scenery, adorned with herds of plains game and the ever-attendant predators.

The Kwando concession is home to more elephant than the entire country of South Africa.



On the morning of departure after your morning activity and breakfast you will be transferred by light aircraft to Kasane airport where you will be transferred by road and boat to Ntwala in Namibia.

Ntwala for 2 nights

Situated 70 kilometres upriver from the Victoria Falls - where white sand beaches and palm trees add to the romance. Ntwala Island Lodge is a wonderfully secluded Chobe destination and comprises of four ultra-luxury styled suites, each inclusive of a private plunge pool and viewing deck; annex bath feature; indoor and outdoor shower; as well as a private sala extending enticingly out over the water.



Ntwala ensures personalised service and culinary expertise as well as privately guided activities (big game, fishing and birding). Ntwala also offers exclusivity and intimacy within a complete holistic African experience. Meander between the multiple waterways with your personal guide and private boat, cruise the quiet backwaters or revel in an exclusive Chobe sunset cruise while viewing a plethora of game. Pursue the famed tigerfish on fly with excitement and anticipation.



After a magical 2 nights at Ntwala you will be transferred onto **Stanley's Safari Lodge in Livingstone.**
